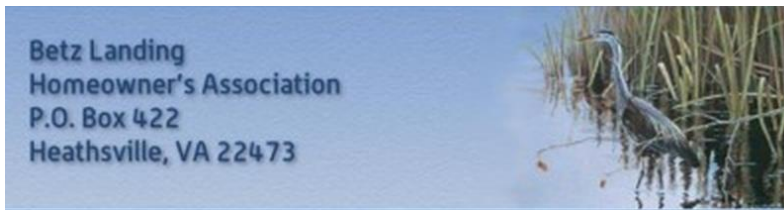

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If, after the Board's consideration and review of the complaint, the Board issues a final decision adverse to the complaint, you have the right to file a notice of final adverse decision with the Common Interest Community Board (CICB) in accordance with the regulations promulgated by the CICB.

### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

This regulation requires that associations set rules for receiving and considering complaints from members and other citizens. Specifically, the regulation (i) requires associations to establish written complaint procedures; (ii) requires the maintenance of association complaint records; (iii) sets time frames in which associations must complete certain actions; (iv) indicates the consequences for failure of an association to establish and utilize a complaint procedure; and (v) establishes procedures and forms for filing a notice of final adverse decision. The law that authorizes the Board to establish these regulations is found in Chapter 29 (§ 55-530) of Title 55 of the Code of Virginia.

It is the association's responsibility to stay informed and follow all regulations and statutes governing associations. It is important to read and become familiar with all regulations applicable to associations. You can stay informed of regulatory actions that may result in changes to the regulations at Virginia Regulatory Town Hall ([www.townhall.virginia.gov](http://www.townhall.virginia.gov)).

This document is a Paraphrased copy of the Common Interest Community Ombudsman Regulations (18 VAC 48-70).
